What is the Mentor Program?

- ♦ A career exploration opportunity for high school juniors and seniors interested in pursuing one of the technical careers available at NCTC Thief River Falls campus.
- ♦ A college mentor will “host” a high school student for a partial class day.
- ♦ High school students will attend lectures with their college mentor and benefit from “hands on” learning experiences.

What are the Benefits?

- ♦ High school students will have direct exposure to the training requirements of the career they are exploring.

When?

- ♦ Generally, mentor experiences will be provided from mid-October to mid-April.
