LITTLE ANGELS

Three and Four Year Olds

Children must be age three by Sept. 1st and fully potty trained. Class size limited to 14 per section (2 teachers).

- **AM or PM sessions held Tuesday and Thursday**
- **Morning Session**
8:15 a.m. to 11:15 a.m.
- **Afternoon Session**
12:15 p.m. to 3:15 p.m.

• **Curriculum prepares students for socialization in a classroom environment.**

LITTLE SAINTS

Four and Five Year Olds

Children must be age four by Sept. 1st and fully potty trained. 10:1 student/teacher ratio. Class size limited to 20 per section (2 teachers).

- **AM or PM sessions held Monday, Wednesday, & Friday**
- **Morning Session**
8:15 a.m. to 11:15 a.m.
- **Afternoon Session**
12:15 p.m. to 3:15 p.m.

• **Curriculum prepares students for Kindergarten.**

Families must submit a completed application and \$30 non-refundable fee for preschool by the registration deadline.

Enrollment Notice: Please note admission is not on a first come basis. Preschool AM or PM preferred sections will be determined by the Child Care Director based on the admission policy.

Does my Child have to be Catholic?

No. This program is open to ALL religious faiths, but it is a Catholic preschool. Prayer is included and bible stories are read and discussed.

Transportation

There is no busing available for the preschool programs.

Registration Information

Enrollment for preschool and preferred sections will be determined by the Child Care Director based on the admission policy. Families must submit a complete registration form and fee by the registration deadline and will be notified in late March regarding preschool acceptance and section assignment.

Complete Registration: After March 1st, you will receive a letter notifying you of placement or waitlist within the program according to our admission policy. If a spot is offered, you will have 30 days to accept placement and complete the online registration and submit the \$125 registration fee.
